

Cascadia Coastal Net Preamble

NET ADVISORY

Good Afternoon, this is (PAUSE) (**FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN**), the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net** will start in 10 minutes on Talk Group **31412**. If you need to make a quick call, please do so now.

[NET CONTROL: Remember to *Identify with your call at least every 10 minutes!!*]

NET PREAMBLE

Good Afternoon, this is (PAUSE) (**FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN**), in (**CITY, STATE**) I will be your Net Control Station this afternoon for the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net**.

The purpose of the net is to share information on upcoming emergency or disaster-related training events and opportunities, as well as, concise After Action Summaries of actual events. This is an informal net organized to foster communication among Coastal Communities, and to build community awareness, prepare for interruption of essential services and disasters, and to enhance resiliency in coastal communities in AK, WA, OR, CA, British Columbia, and other Cascadia coastal communities.

This net meets on the **first** and **third Thursday** of each month at **13:30 Pacific** time on Brandmeister **'Western Oregon' Talk Group 31412**.

This is a directed net. The net is open to all licensed amateurs who have an interest in emergency or disaster-related communications especially those associated with ARES/ RACES, Auxiliary Communications Service, Auxcomm, Hospital Communication groups, Medical Reserve Corps, Community Emergency Response Teams, and Neighborhood Groups.

As with any amateur radio communication, remember to identify with your call sign every 10 minutes and at the end of your conversation. This is a DMR net — Please pause between transmissions.

Are there any upcoming training opportunities, real-world events, exercise follow ups, or actual emergency summaries to share?

Come now with your **FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN, and LOCATION**.

[Instruction: We are looking for disaster-related training events. Take the list and then call on each to make there announcements. Please capture info on trainings — will be posted online]

Are there any more Announcements?

[Instruction: After Announcements are finished – take check ins]

At this time is there anyone who needs an early out?

[Instruction: Take call signs and acknowledge]

This is (**FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN**) your Net Control for the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net.**

[Decide on how you want to take check-ins — State by State or groups states together depending on volume of check-ins]

I'll now take Check-ins from Alaska. Come now with your **FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN, and LOCATION.**

[Instruction: After Alaska move to next State/Province]

*** from British Columbia. Come now with your **FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN, LOCATION.**

[Instruction: After BC move to next State/Province]

*** from Washington. Come now with your **FIRST NAME,**
CALLSIGN, and LOCATION.

[Instruction: After Washington move to next State/Province]

*** from Oregon. Come now with your **FIRST NAME,**
CALLSIGN, and LOCATION.

[Instruction: After Oregon move to next State/Province]

**** from California . Come now with your **FIRST NAME,**
CALLSIGN, and LOCATION.

Are there any late or missed stations that would like to check into
Cascadia Coastal Community Net?

EPILOGUE - CLOSING THE NET

This is (PAUSE) (CALLSIGN) Net Control for this afternoon's net.
Before we close the net, is there anyone who has not already
checked-in who would like to check-in at this time? This is the last
call for net check-ins. (PAUSE)

[Instruction: Pause for late check-ins and recognize them.]

Are there any questions or comments regarding the announcements on the net this afternoon? (PAUSE)

This is (PAUSE) **(CALLSIGN)** I would like to thank all participating stations for your time and cooperation as well as the information shared.

(PAUSE)

This is (PAUSE) **(CALLSIGN)** closing the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net** at 14:___ hours and returning this Talk Group and associated DMR repeaters to normal operation.
