NET ADVISORY

Good Afternoon, this is (**FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN**), the Cascadia Coastal Community Net will start in 10 minutes on Talk Group 31412. If you need to check your radio settings or make a quick call, please do so now.

[NET CONTROL: This is a good time to ask for a Radio Check to make sure folks are hearing you!! Remember to ***Identify with your call at least every 10 minutes!!***]

NET PREAMBLE

Good Afternoon, this is (**FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN**), in (**CITY, STATE**). I will be your Net Control Station this afternoon for the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net**.

The purpose of this net is to share information on upcoming emergency or disaster-related training events, as well as, concise After Action Summaries.

This informal net was organized to foster communication among Communities located along the coast from Northern California to Alaska. The goal of this net is to enhance resiliency in preparation for interruption of essential services and disasters in the coastal communities of Cascadia.

This net meets on the **first** and **third Thursday** of each month at **13:30 Pacific** time on Brandmeister '**Western Oregon**' Talk Group **31412**.

This is a directed net. The net is open to all licensed amateurs who have an interest in disaster-related communications especially those associated with Auxcomm and other Emergency Communications Groups.

As with any amateur radio communication, remember to identify with your call sign every 10 minutes and at the end of your conversation.

TAKE CHECK INS

The net is now open for Check-Ins. I'll take a few stations at a time and then pause and acknowledge those stations. As you check in, please let me know if **you have an ANNOUNCEMENT** of upcoming training events or lessons learned from exercises or actual emergencies.

Please remember this is a DMR net: allow time between transmissions.

Please come now with your **FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN, LOCATION.** Wait for me to acknowledge you before giving your announcements.

[Instruction: We are looking for disaster-related training events. Take the list and then call on each to make there announcements. Please capture any info. After calling a few time — give one last call.]

LATE OR MISSED

This is (**FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN**) your Net Control for the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net**. Are there any late or missed stations? Come now with your **FIRST NAME, CALLSIGN, and LOCATION.**

EPILOGUE - CLOSING THE NET

This is **(CALLSIGN)** Net Control for this afternoon's net. Before we close the net, is there anyone who has not already checked-in who would like to check-in at this time?

This is the last call for net check-ins.

Are there any questions or comments regarding the announcements on the net this afternoon?

This is **(CALLSIGN)** I would like to thank all participating stations for your time and cooperation as well as the information shared.

This is **(CALLSIGN)** closing the **Cascadia Coastal Community Net** at 14:___ hours and returning this Talk Group and associated DMR repeaters to normal operation. 73 to all. **(CALLSIGN)** Clear
